### **Quaker Bakers**

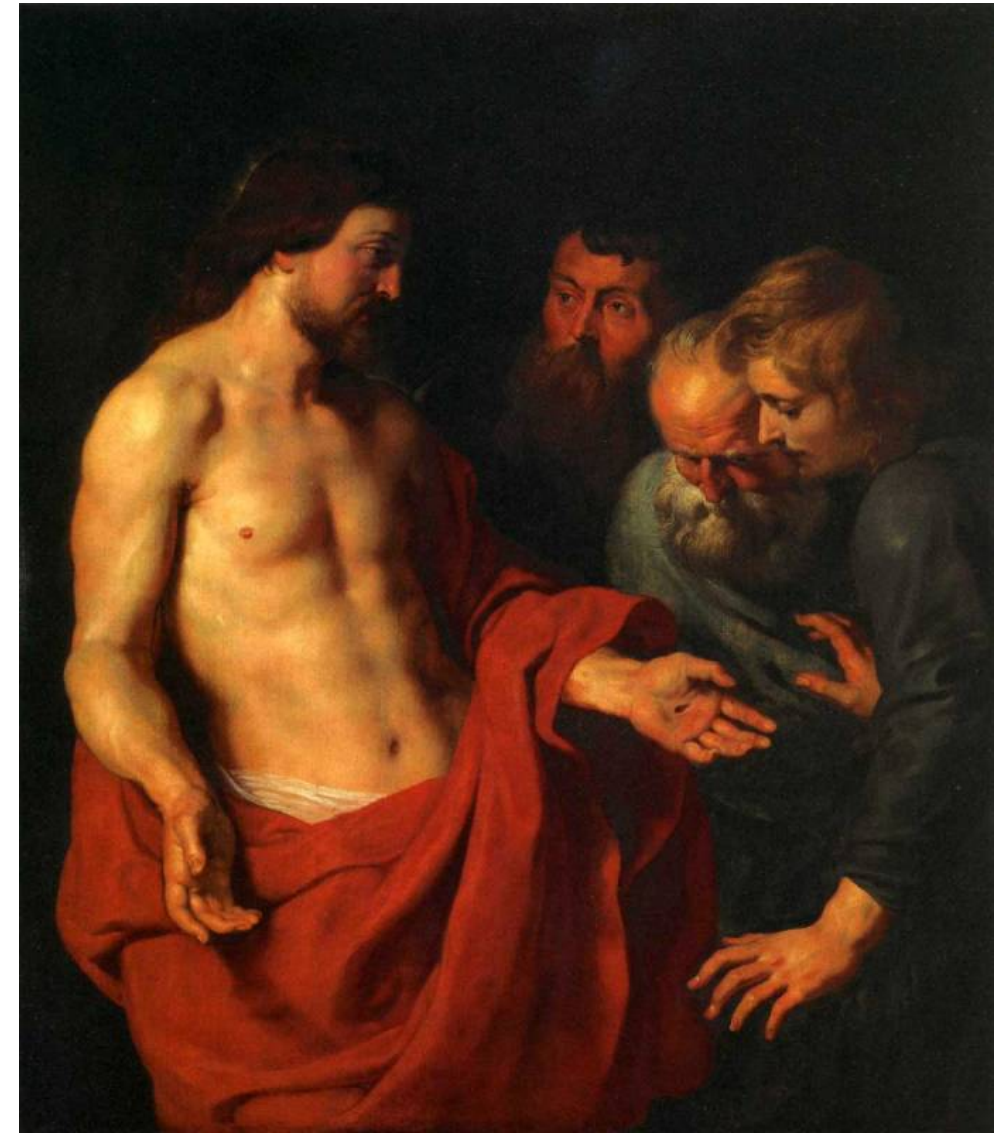
