Quaker Bakers

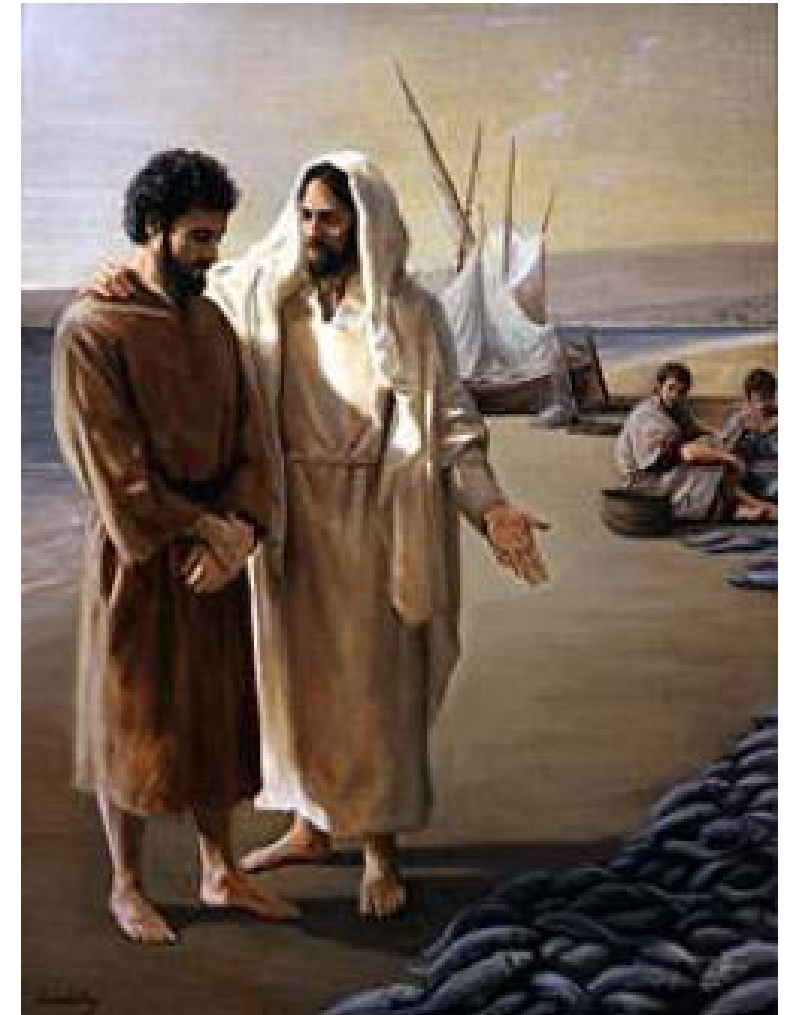
